

### First Nomination Won in Frankfort

Gov. McCreary held his first convention held in the city in 1875. Not many State conventions have been held in Frankfort but whenever the Capital City votes but the seal of approval is a candidate, he always is able to "come back". This fact is amply proven in the case of Gov. McCreary, who was nominated for Governor in Frankfort in 1875.

The Democratic convention of 1875 was a famous one and after the county mass convention were held, it was believed that Gen. "Cerro Gordo" Williams had secured enough instructed votes to nominate him on the first ballot. His friends came to Frankfort confident of his selection as the nominee for Governor.

His opponents were James B. McCreary and J. Stoddard Johnston. The two together had a considerable vote in the convention and with the uncommitted votes had almost enough to prevent a nomination on the first ballot.

With that condition of affairs, the county here was much divided. The friends of the two warring candidates for Governor were

at hand. The uncommitted vote was won, but a few more votes were needed to name either McCreary or Johnston. There was some feverish scheming and hurrying to and fro for many hours. Finally Johnston withdrew and his strength went to Gov. Williams, who was nominated over General Williams by only a few votes.

Gov. McCreary was not as well known in the State then as he is now, and as the Republic case selected John M. Harlan, a famous lawyer, orator, and delegate to run against McCreary, the Democrats felt some uneasiness over the result, but McCreary won easily by over 5,000 majority in the general election on August 1875.

Thirty-six years later this Frankfort-nominated man again became a candidate for Governor. This time a primary election was held to decide on the nominee and he won by a large majority. This time another famous lawyer and a judge of the Circuit Court, Edward C. O'Neal, was nominated against him, and again the Democrats were somewhat doubtful of the result, but with the seal of Frankfort's approval on him, he surprised his friends by winning by a 35,000 majority. Frankfort again nominated him for Governor.
