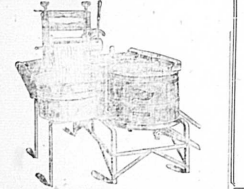
While the very common stock is not wanted and is selling at very low prices, all tobacco from the common grades up is selling at higher prices, and the good grades as you will see from the above are selling high.
