### KENTUCKY TAX TOLL HIGH

(Courier-Journal)

A recent survey by the American  
Automobile Association indicates  
the excessive rate at which taxation  
of the motorist has increased in the  
past several years. While the total  
increase of motor vehicle registra-  
tion tax was 15 per cent, the  
increase in special taxes, which  
does not include personal property  
taxes, was 18 per cent. Kentucky's  
total tax, in the form of li-  
cense fees, registration and motor-  
fuel and gasoline taxes a total of  
\$1.85 per gallon, is the highest in the  
country.
