It costs more than twice as much to run the states today as it did in 1919. The cost of running the states in 1919 was \$11.17 per capita, compared with \$22.34 per capita in 1930. The increase is due to the fact that the states have had to pay for the 48th year of the federal income tax, the per capita revenue being \$12.84 in 1930 as compared with \$11.17 in 1919.

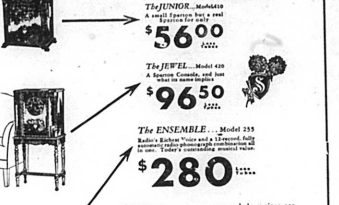
