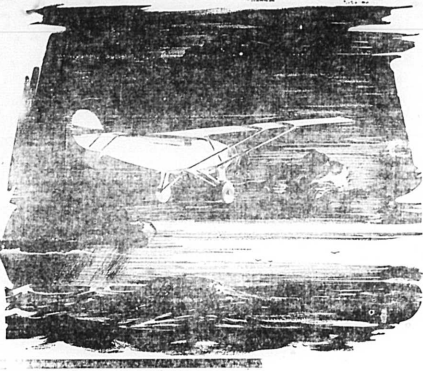


Onward Into the Dawn of a NEW YEAR
