

Tobacco Growers! SELLING CHARGES Reduced at Cynthiana

There has been great agitation throughout the State by Tobacco Growers, advocating a Reduction in Warehouse Charges. We have watched with interest the mass meetings held by the Growers and the decisions and opinions given by Warehousemen. In almost every case the Warehouse Corporations have held that because of the light weight of this year's tobacco, their overhead and taxes remaining about the same, that it is impossible for them to operate at a minimum of less than 75c per hundred.

NEVERTHELESS

At a meeting of the Warehousemen of Cynthiana, it was unanimously agreed and adopted that all Warehouses Act as One, in Reducing
Our Cost To 25c and 2 1/2% With 65c Per Hundred Minimum,
With A Minimum Charge of 25c Per Basket. This Simply Means That No Basket Should Weigh Less Than 40 Pounds.

He is close to home—on a Home Market—where the money made in warehouse fees had to go into the pockets of home workers.
