With Adequate Street Lighting?

More than 35,000 persons were killed and crippled by 1,200,000 injured in automobile accidents in the United States last year. This is an appalling record, a shameful record for a civilized nation.

reckless driving is blamed for some of it. Road defects, failure of tires and mechanical parts of cars cause many of the fatalities.

But a surprisingly large proportion of the deaths and injuries results from apparently unaccountable accidents occurring in poorly-lighted streets.

About 50 per cent of traffic fatalities occur in the daytime when four-fifths of all traffic in Metropolitan Life Insurance Company territory are on the roads.

The other 50 per cent of fatalities occur after sunset in one-fourth of the traffic.

The National Safety Council reports that 35 per cent of all night accidents are directly due to poor street illumination.

Many cities and towns are economizing on street lights at the tragic expense of the limbs of taxpayers - of husbands and fathers, wives and mothers, sons and daughters.
