Tried and Found Worthy

The driver of the 1935 V 8 Ford car in this picture being founded on the floor of our garage, and with car in low gear and throttle wide open, plinged through the brick wall, fell eight feet to the road in alley, landing on trees as shown in picture, with only slight injuries to himself.

Without any adjustments whatever the starter cranked the motor, after which it was driven four miles, running perfectly. Upon removing motor to make sure of its condition the only damage found was the side rails of the main frame very slightly sprung upward at front of body, which was corrected in our shop in a half hour's time.

Below the main frame the spring, shock absorber parts and which were found in perfect condition, with the front axle and main steering rod slightly bent, not enough to interfere with steering. Doors opened and closed perfectly, and only the right rear glass cracked.
