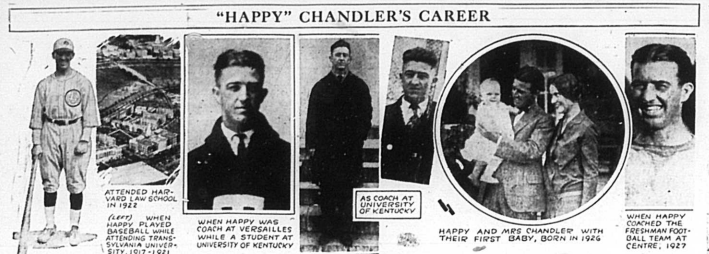


A. B. "Happy" Chandler, whose life history reads like a novel, has been elected to the Kentucky State Board of Education...
