What Insurance Must
Be Taken Before Sept. 30
What insurance has been made
available to producers who
are what for harvest. Such
policies are handled through the
Federal Crop Insurance Corp. and
applicants desiring a policy for wheat
must have a policy written prior
to the time when it is seeded and
not later than Sept. 30. These
policies will insure loss in yield
of wheat due to drought, flood,
hail, wind, frost, wetness,
lightning, fire, insects, rodents,
plant diseases, excessive or
deficient moisture, injury to
crops and against loss in yield
due to other natural causes
which are unavoidable. If you
insure on an all coverage policy,
the insurance policy will cover
the County Agricultural Com-
missioner's Office immediately.
