

\$52,316,000 Is State's Budget Next Two Years

Weather Bureau Promises Little Warmer Weather Today

Governor Johnson Gives Proposal To Opening Session Of Legislature

WOULD EXCEED INCOME

Gov. Owen Johnson and the Legislature Council recommended Tuesday to the governing General Assembly a two-year budget program appropriations \$52,316,000 in excess of expected revenue.

Johnson proposed, however, to "narrow the apparent spread" by "tight economy" in his expenditure of discretionary funds, and the Legislature Council recommended "strengthening of present laws in eight instances further to reduce the prospective deficit."

Prospects for further reduction of the state debt, at least before July 1, were virtually eliminated in Governor Johnson's message.

Declaring increased appropriations after passage of the last regular budget act and a decrease of revenue under estimates had increased an apparent deficit of \$81,118,000 in the budget of the present fiscal year, the Governor said.

This amount of appropriation must be withheld from the state treasury in order that these outlays for which the estimated income is not provided be met.
