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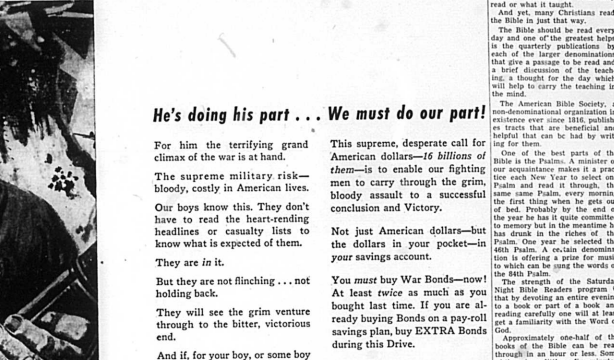

Saturday Night Bible Readers

A Sunday by the Sea. D. M. Moody is credited with saying that the Bible without the Spirit is like an uncooked pie. Moody's words are full of meaning in the matter of daily reading of the Bible. It is not enough to have the Bible in your hands. It must be read and the substance of what you read or what is taught.

And yet, many Christians read the Bible in just that way. The Bible should be read every day and one of the greatest helps in the quarterly publications by such of the larger denominations that give a passage to be read and a brief discussion of the teaching. The American Bible Society, a non-denominational organization in existence over 100 years, has many tracts that are beneficial and helpful that can be had for nothing for them. The recent report of a United States Navy doctor has resulted in considerable discussion and it is in the purpose of this article to clear up some of the confusion which apparently hangs about the testing of dairy cattle for tuberculosis. One of the questions frequently asked is whether Bang's disease testing of dairy cattle is compulsory. The answer is No. It is not compulsory except in Grade A milk. The Carlin's milk is not graded, because there is no milk containing in force which would make it compulsory.

However, some of the dairymen have had their own Bang's and Tuberculosis tests made on their own. They are fully convinced that before such an addition is made that there is no need for such a test. Evidence at the time of purchase of the milk is sufficient to show that the cattle have been tested for tuberculosis. At the present time, the Carlin's milk is not graded, because there is no milk containing in force which would make it compulsory.

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
