Rot Resistant Tobacco Varieties To Be Shown

Black root rot in tobacco fields is causing tremendous losses this season in Nicholas county, according to Wm. T. Bryant, county agent. The worst damage has been observed in Elizabethtown, where the disease has been reported in the past.

On Thursday, August 16, some field meetings will be held. 10:00 o'clock, at near Fugate school at John Ferguson's place. J. J. Fisher's farm and Kach Ralston at the adjoining Shunklin Place farm and at 2:00 o'clock, p. m. at Butlerville at Earl Anderson and Tom E. Jackson's.

The results obtained with rot resistant varieties and damaged tobacco from rot with non-resistant varieties will be shown. Dr. W. D. Valdez, plant pathologist from the Kentucky Experiment Station, in charge of the tobacco variety research work will attend and assist with the meetings.
