**Concessions Allow Funds For Surveys Of Burley**

Measuring of tobacco acreage on all farms producing burley in 1945 was provided for in the \$3,600,000 annual deficit appropriation act passed by the House of Representatives.

The bill allows \$400,000 to the Agricultural Adjustment Administration for use in making the surveys.

For the past two years, the AAA has not made official measurements of burley acreage. Compliance forms have been turned in by the growers themselves.

Resumption of surveys by the AAA had been agreed by tobacco growers in both burley and flue-cured areas.
