ORDINANCE NO. G-7.

SECTIONS 1916 CITY STREETS OVER WHICH WATER AND FEDERAL HIGHWAYS ARE ROUTED AS PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM. AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of Carlisle, Kentucky to enter into agreement with the Department of Highways, Commonwealth of Kentucky, to carry out the purposes of Section 177.041, to 177.047 inclusive of the Kentucky Revised Statutes designating any streets or portions thereof including viaducts and bridges connecting links of State or Federal interstates highways, to be constructed, repaired, reconstructed or reconstructed of such streets, viaducts or bridges, as provided by the aforesaid statute.

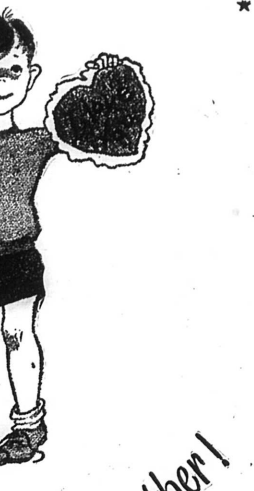
