The abundance of hay and
pasture in Kentucky gives farmers
an exceptional opportunity to
engage in the national program
to save food, and authorities
announced at the University
of Kentucky Experiment Station
at Lexington. A large amount
of hay was produced this year
and there is much grain to pasture
in most parts of the state.
It was said that stores could
be obtained on the basis of
extraordinary conditions of
extra pasture and hay and other
with little or no cost. This would
save 30 to 40 cents of cost per
ton.
The Kentucky cow-calf
industry is making it possible to produce
100 to 200-pound milk calves
with little or no cost.
Every calf that is filled with
grasses and legumes and
grown on pasture will cost
less than 10 cents to produce.
Some more pigs at farrowing
time, feeding balanced
ration, would require less
breeding stock and less
hay would be available to use
grain.
Slipping-farrowing hogs
and raising of electric hogs
help to save pigs. Some
pigs are now being raised
on pasture and are
being sold at a profit.
This requires an extra-large
farrowing pen for each
litter.
