Interpretations Differ

There is a science called semantics, which has made the meaning of words and phrases. An apparently plain statement may mean one thing to one man and a quite different thing to another. The purpose of semantics is to make sure that words have the same meaning in all circumstances. It is a science that has made much headway in the world, to get rid of this confusion, and give words a definite meaning.

This illustrates one of the difficulties which has helped to produce the current crisis between Russia on the one hand and the Western allies on the other. American and British diplomats meet with Moscow, Stalin, and other Soviet leaders, and have apparently arrived at agreement. Then, a few days or a few weeks later, it appears that the Russians put an entirely different interpretation on what was said and written. That happened at Yalta, where President Roosevelt came away with a completely different idea of what had been agreed upon than that held by President Stalin. The same words were used on both sides—but the meaning was different.

In the Moscow conference on the Berlin blockade, the Western representatives, General Smith, had little to say for publication, but news reports had been made that Stalin had been in his office with General Smith, and that they had had a long conference. In the Moscow conference, the most important was an agreement to issue a resolution, under four-power control, in the area.

The subsequent Russian actions immediately disrupted our hopes. Regardless of what Stalin had said, the Russians had not intended to do anything. They thought Stalin meant—the Soviet Union was not to be bound by the terms of the agreement, and they kept on trying to break up the Russian blockade.
