Pritchard, had tried to get the Bourbon board to delay its purge until after the primary. Pritchard, he said, telegraphed him July 13th and sharply criticized the State Board's appointment of Buckner, Cleaver and Allen to the Bourbon Purge Board."

"He told me that anybody who had anything to do with these appointments will never carry Bourbon County again," O'Connell said.

Pritchard today confirmed the conversation with O'Connell. "And I meant it, too," he added.

O'Connell said later that same day Buckner telephoned him. "He told me Pritchard told the board I had looked into the law and I was afraid that to adjourn right then and resume their purge after the primary," he told Mr. Buckner that he was an outright lie. I had not told Mr. Pritchard any such thing."
