The Purgatorial Laws Don't Do Their Job

Kentucky voters are being misled during the past few years, to improve the old saying that "Kentucky politics are the damnedest in the world." It has been a truth and not merely successful fight. Our state has more than its share of gray-headed congressmen, county clerks and judges, and the honest citizens who have attempted to carry their democratic duties have been handicapped by their work with a set of confused, contradictory and unneeded laws.

Our citizens in Harlan, Bourbon, Fayette, Pike, Knox and Boone counties had failed to purge ineligible voters from registration lists which governed their actions.

Representative Joseph Spang and Senator R. Reynolds now propose a number of changes to present election laws, aimed at making it easier to remove ineligible voters from voting lists, and making it more difficult for voters to carry out a ballot. The changes they propose are sound. They would define more clearly the qualifications of voters and general practices of boards of registration. They would require signatures of all persons appearing to vote, and make it more difficult to use ineligible voters in election returns. They would also make purgation lists more accurate and more reliable.

In the general Assembly, it is sincerely hoped that it will also take up the proposed corrective measures. And it will appear a board to study our election laws, with a view toward complete revision in the near future.
