Social Hygiene Observance

The annual observance of Social Hygiene Day will be held in Kentucky and throughout the nation on Wednesday, February 7. The theme for this year's program is "Safe and our strong hold-over family."

In those days of national emergency the protection and practice of Social Hygiene is particularly important and communities such as ours are urged to join in the observance of Social Hygiene Day.

The Social Hygiene program is aimed at the prevention of venereal disease and other unsalubrious community conditions through concerted work by the home, the church, the school and other agencies.

In cooperation with the observance, the V.D. Division of the Kentucky State Department of Health stands ready to furnish free and confidential information on venereal diseases. The National County Health Department also has literature on this subject.

According to the 1949 Kentucky Vital Statistics Report, 5,801 cases of gonorrhea were reported during the year and 4,022 cases of syphilis. This means that VD still ranks first among serious communicable diseases in this state, as in the nation.

Fighting VD requires public knowledge and united action. Widespread observance of Social Hygiene Day can help.
