Minor Elements In Soil Investigation by University of Kentucky Experiment Station indicates that in much of the state certain large number of the so-called minor elements necessary for the growth of crops are lacking.

Limestone and marl, it is noted, contained copper, cobalt, manganese, zinc and phosphorus. Other elements found in amounts ranging from traces to 20 pounds per ton included nickel, silicon, aluminum, phosphorus and sodium.

The fact that these elements are readily available in soils may account for the lack of improvement of crops to which they are applied, it is stated in an annual report of the Experiment Station.
