RFC Influence Peddling

A report covering the results and conclusions drawn from the recent Reconstruction Finance Corporation study in Washington was mailed to this office this week by Senator Thomas E. Underwood, a member of the Committee on Expenditures in the Executive Department and also a member of the Subcommittee on Investigations.

This report, which gave an unbiased account of influence peddling, possible graft and corruption that took place in this department since the passage of the law which set up such a thing with amazing clarity just how low, unethical and unscrupulous the use of influence by government officials can be.

Although conceding an error that could be possible by law or improvement these influence peddlers violated many of the basic ethical laws and standards upon which government should be founded.

We sincerely hope that the Committee on Investigations will continue to work on this important issue in government wherever they can find it.

This country is deeply indebted to the St. Louis Post-Dispatch, the newspaper which conducted this campaign, and the committee that conducted the investigation, and to the Senate Committee of which Mr. Underwood is a member, for bringing these happenings to light, and sending the message to the American people.
