In The Service

A Blue Cross-Blue Shield group endorsement campaign is currently being conducted in Nicholas county, according to Charles Kent, county auditor.

The Blue Cross plan is a plan for providing hospital bills and is sponsored by the Kentucky Mutual Hospital Association, locally known as the Blue Cross. It is not a profit organization which is governed by a board of directors, all of whom are hospital administrators, doctors, and some laymen who give their efforts free of charge.

The Blue Cross plan has been known for approximately twenty years. It has provided financial aid for those who are unable to pay the hospital bills and hospital charges.

Hospitals are more costly than they used to be, and this is especially true in the case of those who are unable to pay the hospital bills and hospital charges.
