Governor Lawrence M. Withers has proclaimed May 1 as Child Health Day, following a similar statement by President Hoover.

The child health day is observed by marking the twenty-fifth anniversary of the Child Health Act of 1907.

The Governor's Proclamation urged all parents to take their children to the nearest "well-attended, modern individual, capable of giving the children's disease and respiratory ailments and pneumonia."

The provisions of Child Health Day, according to Lad M. Snyder, D. D., Director of the Division of Maternal and Child Health, Kentucky State Department of Health, stated the "annual statement of a year-round program for the protection and development of the health of the Nation's children."

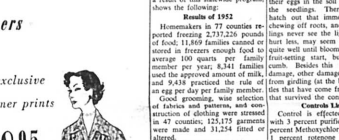
