Your Red Cross Drive

The National County Red Cross drive opened Monday and will last throughout this month.
The Red Cross office here performs several important functions in the course of its business during the year, particularly with respect to helping Servicemen with emergency loans to Servicemen and in many other ways help our boys to uniform.

Another important program that the Red Cross has recently initiated is supplying food to the National Foundation of Infantile Paralysis to help them manufacture gamma globulin, a short term preventive for polio. Experts say that the only way to prevent a major polio epidemic is to supply food for this disease, which is a worry.

To supply food to this program the Red Cross organizes the Bloodmobile unit which has taken here in the past. The Bloodmobile unit is a motor vehicle which is used for the collection of blood for use by wounded fighting men, and the red unit is used for the Public Fundation.

These three units of blood donated here are extremely important in the absence of blood banks. These units of blood will be used many times by this, and will be the finest use of money that can be made.

Your help in going to the Red Cross drive means that these functions are continuous. A worker will soon be around to see you. Give for a warm blanket and a generous contribution.
