# ATTENTION FARMERS

We are handling the drought mixed feeds formulated to meet the government specifications.

Mix No. 1, containing 1,000 lbs. of drought relief corn, 500 lbs. of wheat and enough cottonseed meal, molasses and minerals to bring it up to a 16% protein ration sells for \$84.20 a ton with a reduction of \$21.40 per ton for the drought certificate.

Mix No. 2, containing 1,500 lbs. of corn and enough cottonseed meal molasses, etc. to bring it up to a 20% protein ration sells for \$83.00 per ton and the certificate is worth \$17.60.

This makes Mix No. 1 cost the farmer with a certificate \$62.80 per ton and Mix No. 2 cost \$65.40 per ton. These certificates are obtainable by a qualified

farmer at the ASC Office in the Basement of the Courthouse
