Isolation TB Law Effective June 19
After June 19, persons who have tuberculosis and do not take precautions to prevent its spread will be subject to fines or imprisonment. The bill requires local health officers who have a TB patient under their care to file a report with the State Department of Health. Under the new law, which is phased in, an observer isolation hospital in Hazard, spreading tuberculosis would be fined \$500 or receive a six month jail term or both.
