Kentucky farmers who need an establishment of (1) permanent pasture in carrying out conservation practices during long spring and summer this year should file applications for federal conservation work under the Agricultural Conservation Program for 1934-35, covering the period from July 1 to June 30, 1935. Applications for conservation work under this program should be filed at once.

ACF assistance may be requested at any time before the practice is established. It is not necessary to file an application for the 1934-35 season until the first of July. Applications for conservation work under this program should be filed at once.

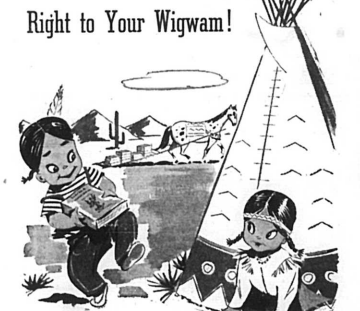
