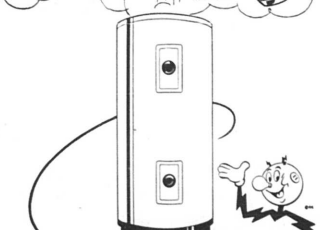

**AN ORDINANCE TO CLARIFY AND BRING UP TO DATE FORMER ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE SALE OF GAS AND WATER FROM THE MUNICIPAL UTILITIES BY THE CITY OF CARLISLE.**

The City Council of the City of Carlisle, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:  
(1) All prospective users of gas or water are required to make written application at the City Clerk's Office in the City Hall before obtaining gas or water service and to post a cash pledge to insure prompt payment of bills for same, if required.  
(2) All bills, not paid within 10 days of the date thereof, will have 1% added as a penalty for extra utility work caused thereby. The City reserves the right to cut off service to any user, without notice, whose bill remains unpaid 15 days after the date thereof and to exact a service charge of \$2.00 for cutting it off and turning on again.  
(3) Any user wanting premises supplied with gas or water will be charged a one-time unit service charge to be determined by the City Clerk's Office.  
(4) All gas and water to be sold through meters at the prevailing rate, except that a flat monthly rate may be established where it is impractical to install meters.  
(5) A shut-off valve to be provided by the user, between the meter and the first faucet or appliance on the premises, for use when disconnecting or repairing faucets or appliances, and when returning same.  
(6) No meter, regulator or line valve, that has been installed by the City, shall be adjusted, turned on or off or tampered with without the approval of a designated representative of the City. A fine of not more than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 in hereby provided for any violation.  
(7) All ordinances on point of amendments, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
