Final count approval of appropriation of \$25,000 for the construction of an armory in Carlisle was included in the request for \$1,262,000, forwarded to federal officials at Washington last week by Adjutant General H. H. Donohoe, head of the Kentucky National Guard. Construction of an armory here has been approved by the army committee.
