### How to kill poison ivy

How to kill poison ivy without injury to the tree in which it is climbing is explained by N. R. Elliott, Extension Horticulturist at the University of Kentucky. Combine equal parts of one part of 2-4 D and 10 parts of 2-4 N. The spray is very effective.

### Fall barley plant bed tips given

Prepare barley plant beds in the fall and it will mean extra dollars in next year's barley to harvest crop. The provision of a free wintering center, says Russell Hunt, Extension horticulturist at the University of Kentucky.

In making plant beds now, Hunt recommends using other materials, Vaseline or other soil conditioners. These fill broadcast plants and grasses, their germinating needs, and keep and moisten.
