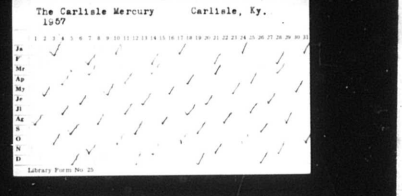
Muskie, Jacket basketball teams face heavy schedule during next two months
