Despite progress made during the past four years, far too many Kentuckians die unnecessarily, especially children, from such diseases as diphtheria, polio, tetanus, typhoid and whooping cough.

This view has been expressed by C. C. Howard, M.D., Glasgow, chairman of the Kentucky State Medical Association Public Health Committee, as part of the statewide observance this week of "Immunization Week in Kentucky."

This educational effort, which has been conducted by the medical association each year since 1946, is designed to bring the importance of immunizing pre-school age children, school children and the general public to the attention of every family through a series of radio and television "Prevention features for 1957."
