STATE GEOLOGIST TO JOIN UK STAFF

Wallace W. Hagan, Owensboro geologist who has been acting in opening up Western Kentucky's oil reserves in recent months, will join the University of Kentucky staff Aug. 15 as director of the Kentucky Geological Survey and state geologist.

Hagan, who has been 40, has found or contributed to the extension of 16 miles of the area.

Employed by the Ohio Petroleum Co. and stationed in Owensboro from 1948 to 1953, he did well-earning work on "wildcat" and exploratory geological work in Kentucky and Southern Illinois coal drill program.

Leaf-spot may affect tomatoes

Leaf-spot diseases may hit Kentucky tomato plants in the near future, says one of two recommended sprays to check such fungus diseases, says Kentucky Experiment Station pathologist.

The recommended material contains zinc or mancozeb. During rainy weather spray weekly in dry weather, spray every 10 days to two weeks, in other directions carefully.

When frost begins to set in, start a spray program that will last the remainder of the season.
