Silent weeping

Writing in The Saturday Evening Post of October 18, Demarre Bose, a foreign correspondent of long and varied experience, tells of the "Silent Weapon of the Cold War." Its name is a grim one: Russian Inflation.

The purpose of his article is to show how inflation can and does "break the human spirit as completely as famines, earthquakes and revolutions." He has watched it in France, in Eastern Europe, elsewhere.

And he says it clear the way for Communist rule in China after World War II. Just as it did in Russia after World War I. Russian inflation, in his view, has been experienced only twice in this country—during revolutionary wars, and the Confederate "Red." "But," he goes on, " Soviet strategists have given notice that they expect our lack to change, partly because of our own inflationary policies, partly because of the Russian's particular economic warfare against us."

Money's main attention, as he sees it, has shifted from the arena prior to this kind of warfare. That was a purely logical shift, from the Communist viewpoint, because, he predicted that economic warfare would be a more potent weapon than armed force in bringing about a worldwide Bolshevik revolution. To quote again: "The word is flashed upon the basic belief that Communism will sooner or later stand its ground on the ruins of a free economic system which has been built up by the combination of their own financial irresponsibility and unrelenting foreign conquest."

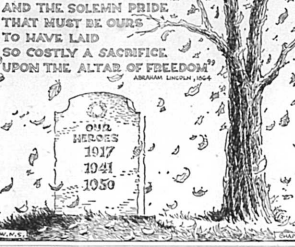
Here Mr. Bose points to a matter of great importance which is little known in this country. Soviet economists are orthodox conservatives. They have stubbornly clung to such established notions as balanced budgets and sound money. And their domestic economic measures are almost all of an anti-inflationary type.

He describes, in detail, a number of examples of how the silent weapon of runaway inflation has brought nations into Communist hands. One in China, where the Chiang Kai-shek government had small understandings of economic principles and failed to undertake necessary currency reforms. And in the destruction of Germany, where the Allies' American business groups welcomed the Red Army into Germany, figuring that the Reds couldn't be any worse than Hitler.
