Kentuckians suffer from court limitations

The wheels of justice turn slowly, and it is generally agreed that they turn slowest in Kentucky.
The Kentucky Court of Appeals is the most overworked and under-staffed organization in state government. An average of 673 cases are filed in the Court annually. The most backlogs occur in the cases of 1825, 1826 and 1827.
The judicial department and courts in case of 12 areas in the Kentucky constitution proposed limited constitutional convention would be concerned with all the proposals of the November 8 election.
If the proposal passed, any changes made in the judicial system would be up to the 100 constitutional delegates elected by the voters and then any changes made would not become law unless the same voters approved them.
The most frequently voiced proposal to improve the court system was to set up specialized courts, such as traffic and juvenile courts, and to create an intermediate court that would be placed directly under the Court of Appeals.
When Kentucky's present constitution, which defines and limits the number of courts in the state, was written in 1892, a fast and efficient judicial system for that era was established.
The court system set up in the '90s was six, when coming home from a morning service, she said.
