Twenty years ago

Twenty years ago, December 24, 1940, Santa Claus will bring the joyful families in Nicholas County this year as the result of efforts made by various organizations and the churches. Approximately 600 sacks of candy and fruit will be distributed at the Community Christmas tree at the Army Post, day after tomorrow. The Boy Scouts will distribute toys which have been collected and recommended by the Women's Club will distribute dolls, among the gifts. The Farm Bureau organization of the Carlisle high school, in their Let's Act Ape project, distributed approximately 100 baskets of fruit among the isolated families of the County. White gifts were contributed at the various churches. Sunday and distributed among the needy families of the community.

The turkey market for Christmas was a disappointment to hundreds of turkey raisers. Two days during the Christmas season were 14 to 17 cents, about a penny less than the price of the former year. In November, Kentucky's turkey tobacco markets dropped Friday to \$12.25 a hundred pounds, the lowest for the season, as the market closed for Christmas holidays. The markets will re-open December 26 but will close one day January 1. Sixteen of the markets reported lower averages, seven of which were lower than last week.

Owners of shares in the Nicholas County Building and Saving Association received a Christmas present. Members who check totaling \$4,241 were ready for distribution as dividends on the shares. Usually the dividends are not paid until after the first of the year.
