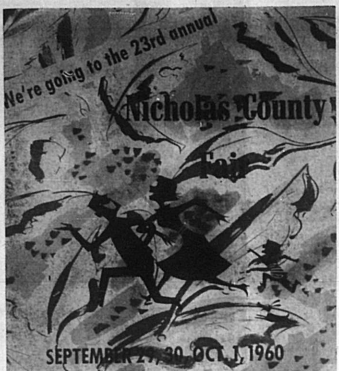
Telephone Talk
