Time For Alfalfa Probably the greatest need in Kentucky's livestock program is more and better hay, silage and other roughage. Along with some grain and protein supplements, roughage is the main item which most milk and wool are made. Good pastures are the basis for a strong livestock production, but high quality legume hay or silage is also the essential for efficient dairy and sheep production. To insure that you are getting the most out of your alfalfa, look for these signs:

At the first signs of the insects, begin a systematic control program using DDT, TDE, Dieldrin or Sevin. Two applications eight to ten days apart may be necessary for good control. DDTs are safer to use than cumulation concentrates. The control program for bedbugs should also be valuable in controlling hornworms and flea beetles.
