master. This is a young bird presented to the UK 12-13 months old, weighing 8 lb. by the Society.

It has the best of both worlds. You can fry, broil, or roast this turkey.

If you have a large family and are expecting several guests, the bigger turkey is cheaper per lb. You can buy a 15 lb. turkey and it will serve half of it and freeze the rest for a later use. Some markets have turkey parts for sale which the family can have only white meat or dark meat which is preferred.

A general rule allow 1 lb. to 1 1/2 lb. per serving for the turkey. If you are serving 10, a large ready-to-cook bird allows 1 1/2 to 2 lb. per serving. The large birds will yield about 2 1/2 whole meat and 1/3 dark meat.

When selecting a turkey for roasting select one that is full fleshed and meaty with a good layer of fat to help keep it tender and juicy while roasting.

on a half-time basis, collecting for the members of the county unions. Now he is looking for all types of historical material.

These materials are used in the Library regularly by approval scholars, under the supervision of the Archivist Department.

Finch explained that although the Library prepares outright gifts, material may either be deposited there or loaned to the library to be copied by microfilm.

Materials loaned for this purpose are inventoried by Finch before he leaves the home office where he picks them up. A duplicate copy of this inventory is left with the owner of the items and the materials are returned within a short time.

Restrictions may be placed on material, such as confidential items which can not be used for a certain period of years or only on approval of the family. Finch said some businesses and unions have placed this approval restriction so that material can not be misused.

Finch also makes arrangements with county officials for the filming of county records which is done by the Genealogical Society of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. Copies of these films

are available to the public at a fee.
