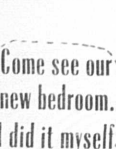

**COOPER AMENDMENT DEFEATED**

Senator John Sherman Cooper (R-Ky.) moved last week to reduce by \$130 million the appropriations bill for the Department of Labor and the Department of Health, Education and Welfare. When the bill came before the Senate, Senator Cooper offered an amendment to cut all items in the bill by 5%, with the exception of grants to States for public assistance, unemployment compensation for Federal employees and ex-servicemen; and employees' compensation claims, which the Congress has a statutory duty to provide.
