shock waves before they reach the ground. The higher the aircraft is flying, the less intense are the sonic boom products. For example, tests have shown that a B-50 flying at 40,000 feet creates booms which sound like distant thunder when heard on the ground. At 30,000 feet, the booms are louder, sounding like close-range thunder. Generally, the sonic booms produced by SAC's "Hustlers" fall somewhere in between these two examples, as authorized by law, 50,000 feet.

Sonic booms cannot cause structural damage to a house or building on display. In-volve a person. The Air Force knows from tests that it takes pressures of 70 or more pounds per square foot to damage ground buildings. In fact, tests with nuclear explosions have shown that it takes 150 to 300 pounds per square foot to damage brick or frame buildings. Pressure from a sonic boom under normal conditions will not be more than five pounds a square foot - roughly ten times the noise created by a thunder clap. The strongest sonic boom ever recorded was measured on a mountain top, 300 feet from the passing aircraft. The pressure of this sonic boom was only 33 pounds per square foot. There is no record of any human injuries ever being incurred as the direct result of a sonic boom.

A marriage of methods, some of the old, but mostly the new!

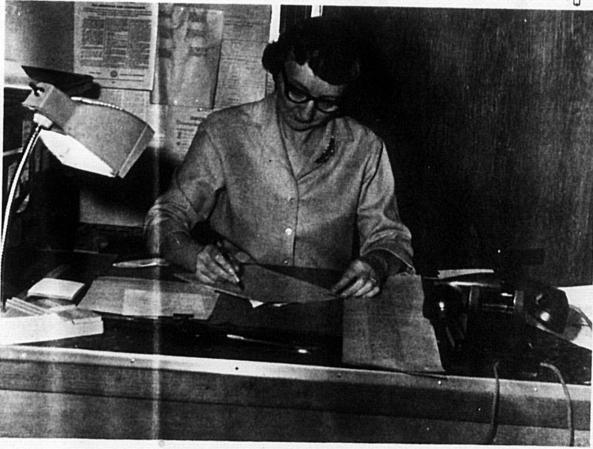
It all began in the fall of 1954, when we read of a Florida newspaper that was using an unconventional method (off-press) to produce a tabloid size newspaper at Fort Pierce. We wrote and asked for a copy and were struck with the clarity of the photographs, though the type face for the bulk of the reading material left us cold. For in fact it was cold. It had never been a hunk of lead, tin and antimony method's 535 degrees in a Linotype pot and forced under pressure into a mold against a line of matrices, it came we were told, and was now reading to produce the cold way with a Linotype and a reproduction of our study. Being we liked a newspaper with pictures, pictures which weren't blobs of ink, that had detail - it seemed to us that off-press was the way - my what a risky way, and costly too!

In late November, 1955, we purchased a small offset press duplicator to some of our less-a machine which enabled the use of all the principles we hoped would serve us in good stead at a later date. There was many a time when we felt like calling the salesman that sold us this temperamental machine there are still times and beg him to relieve us of the devilish thing. For certain types of job printing, it can't be surpassed and possibly if we hadn't had such an investment in old letter presses we would have used it even more.

As the years rolled by, and articles appeared in trade publi-
