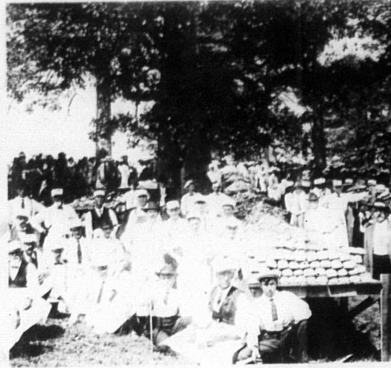

### Diabetes tests available now

Every man, woman and child in Kentucky was urged today by Robert S. Tillett, M. D., Louisville, chairman of the Kentucky State Medical Association's Diabetes Committee, to take advantage of the free diabetes tests offered by physicians, hospitals, and laboratories during National Diabetes Week which begins Sunday.

The importance of early detection of diabetes was stressed by Governor Bert T. Combs who has proclaimed the period from November 1-17 as Diabetes Week in Kentucky.

An estimated 1,700,000 persons in the country and 15,000 in Kentucky alone have undiagnosed diabetes, said Dr. Tillett, and it is to find these people and to give them an opportunity to take advantage of

available control measures that the NSMA has sponsored the Drive annually since 1951.

He emphasized the importance of being tested for diabetes each year, since early detection can greatly simplify the problems of the disease are those that are unaware they have it," he said, "because when caught early, very often the only precautions needed to insure a long life are control of weight and diet."

Mrs. Alexander will do a simple test on urine samples of adults who bring a small sample to the Health Department during the week. The test results indicate whether the person should see a physician for definite diagnosis and treatment.

### Farms may be registered

Do you want to make the title of your farm official? You may do this by registering the name with the State Department of Agriculture. The department's register shows that two names of farms in Nicholas county are registered. The total for the state is 652 and the Blue Grass area includes some of the best-known farm names in the world.

Names of farms in this county registered with the department are Fairbrook and Taylor's Creek Farm.

The State law providing for the registration of farm names states "when a farm name has been recorded as the name of any farm in this state, that name shall not be recorded as the name of any other farm."

This means that once you have recorded your farm's name with the State no other farm may bear this name officially.

You may have the name of your farm recorded by virtue of \$1 and the name and location to the Commissioner of Agriculture at Frankfort. The law provides that he "shall furnish the owner a certificate, as used under seal, setting forth the name and location of the farm and the name of the owner."

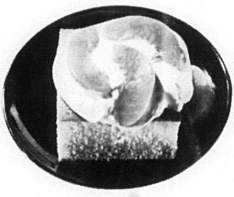

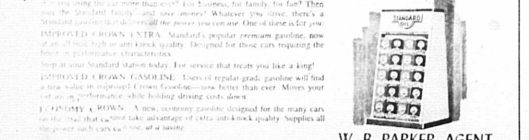
