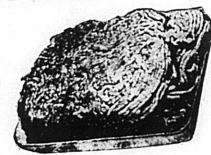

SEPTEMBER-OCTOBER PERIOD SETS NEW RECORDS FOR DRYNESS
Kentucky farmers this year suffered from record dry weather during the period September-October in some state locations.
October itself, says Ben Elam, climatologist with the UK Ag Experiment Station agronomy department, ran from 1 to 2 1/2 inches below average. This was not a record for October dryness, he noted. There have been drier Octobers over the state in many locations.
Elam said that at Lexington, the total rainfall for September-October was 0.70 inches, and the least rainfall recorded in that area for that period since the beginning of uninterrupted records in 1870. The previous record was in 1908 when September-October registered a total of 1.10 inches. "Preliminary information indicates that the two-month period was also the driest since the beginning of weather records at Frankfort (1882) and at Bowling Green (1887)," Elam noted.
Depending on location, rainfall for the entire state for January 1 through October 31 shows a deficit. Most areas in the western part of the state were from 9 to 15 inches under average. 6 to 9 inches behind at many central locations, as much as 15 inches behind at one south central location and from 3 to 12 inches below long-time averages at many locations in the eastern third of Kentucky.
Temperatures for October were from 5 to 6 degrees warmer than average over the western two-thirds of the state. In some locations, it was one of the three warmest Octobers in 78 years. Temperatures ranged from 1 to 2 degrees above average for the eastern third of Kentucky.
