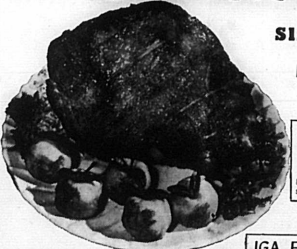

Donald Davie, distinguished English poet from Cambridge University, will serve as George Eliation poetry lecturer for 1963 at the University of Cincinnati.

Mr. Davie's series of lectures at Cincinnati will extend from March 3-April 11. Dr. William S. Clark, II, professor and chairman of the University's department of English, announced.

General subject of Mr. Davie's free public lectures will be "Three Analogies for Poetry." All but one of the programs will be at 4 p.m. The exception will be an 8:30 p.m. lecture March 29 at which Mr. Davie will read selections from his own poetry.

All lectures will be in Room 127, campus McMillen Hall.
Native of Yorkshire, England, Mr. Davie has been a lecturer in English at Cambridge since 1958 and fellow of Cambridge's Gonville and Caius College since 1959. He is director of studies in English at that college.
