Welfare Squad Gets Worse

Farm Bureau has always favored public care or assistance for the needy who are unable to care for themselves. However, the organization views with growing concern the ever-increasing abuse of the welfare program the past several years. The welfare mess in Washington, the nation's capitol, which was uncovered a few months ago by Senator Robert C. Byrd and W. V. J. showed that at least \$18 million has been paid to ineligible relief clients in Washington and the District of Columbia in the past five years. This came rather as a shock to many people and prompted the Kennedy Administration to step up efforts to weed out cheaters from the nation's public relief rolls. Senator Byrd became suspicious when district welfare officials kept asking for supplement funds at a time when the city's population was rapidly declining. His later investigation uncovered a lot of ugly and amazing facts. For example, a random sampling of 300 aid-to-dependent-children showed that 97 percent were not entitled to relief funds.

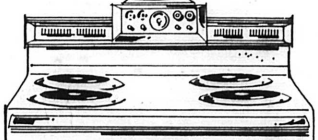

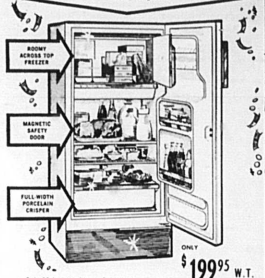

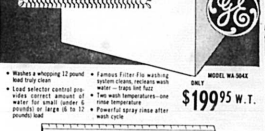
