**Touring Scenic Kentucky By Merry Lovelace**  
Each fall, thousands of people converge on Central Kentucky, the kingdom of the horse. They come from places near and far, to attend a race meeting or a sale at famous Keeneland, to bid at the renowned Tattersalls sales, or watch the harness racing at America's fastest track, the Big Red Mile.

The exploits of the spectacular thoroughbreds are familiar to most people, but his fast-footed brothers are far outnumbered by their equally fast cousins, the standardbreds, the dainty sleepers, the prancing show horses and the hard driving trot racers. A great percentage of the top winning standardbreds were acquired at Tattersalls in Lexington. They may be seen standing in the winner's circles all over the world.

Tattersalls in Lexington began in the 1890's as a branch of the renowned Tattersalls in England. It is now owned by the Lexington Tots Breeders Association and is world famous. In 1962 the all time world record auction price for a standardbred was set at the Lexington sale when Paint er was bought for \$130,000. At that particular sale, 687 horses, more than half of them yearlings, were sold for a total of \$2,881,450.

When someone bids in an unproved yearling at Tattersalls, he is automatically engaged in a gamble of considerable magnitude. He must have the courage of his convictions and the cash to back it up, because pure-blooded horses simply don't come cheap. A colt's sale is heavily influenced by the achievements of his parents. The offspring of some illustrious champion will naturally bring more than one of less distinguished parentage. Championship blood lines, however, are no guarantee of championship offspring. The buyer must gamble on his own judgment. He considers the young aristocrat's conformity, the shapeliness of his legs and body, his markings and his apt temperament.
