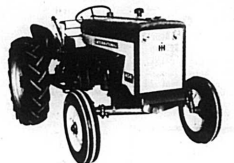

PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY 1917 - 1963

President John F. Kennedy, thirty-fifth president of the United States, was assassinated Friday, November 22, in Dallas, Texas. Kennedy, 46, was shot to death as he rode with his wife, Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy, in an open limousine as they were leaving downtown Dallas, to the Dallas Trade Mart, where he was to speak.

One shot wounded Governor John B. Connally of Texas, but his condition is reported not critical. Within half an hour, Kennedy was dead and the United States was sworn in as President in the cabin of the presidential plane by Federal Judge Sarah T. Hughes of Dallas. After the brief ceremony, the big plane took off carrying the body of the late President. Kennedy's grave in Arlington National Cemetery, with full military honors.

An 'eternal' flame will burn at the head of John F. Kennedy's grave in Arlington National Cemetery, who remembered and lighted an eternal light at the grave-site Sunday night to carry the buoyant spirit of the man. The flame will be fueled at first by a temporary apparatus. A copper tube was run over a distance of about 100 yards to the grave site Sunday night to carry bottled gas to the site. Later a permanent installation to fuel the flame will be made. No such flame has burned before in Arlington.

HOCKETT COMMISSIONED KENTUCKY COLONEL
Paul W. Hockett, Lexington, was commissioned a Kentucky Colonel on Tuesday. The commission was presented by Charles Cox, County Attorney. Mr. Hockett is the stepfather of Mrs. Warren Fisher and is well known in Carlisle.
