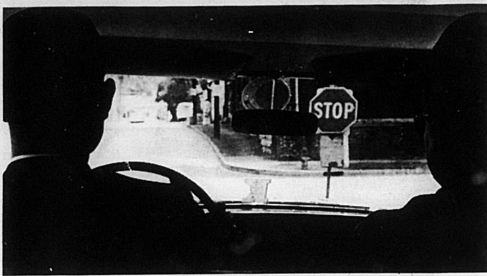


Kentucky Among Top 10 States In Driver Licensing Program

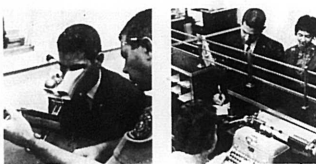
National Safety Council Award Cites State Testing Methods

Kentucky's procedures for testing applicants for drivers' licenses are among the best in the nation, according to the National Safety Council which in 1962 awarded the Kentucky Department of Public Safety a plaque ranking the state among the top 10 states in the important process designed to see that only qualified drivers receive a license.

This national recognition points up the fact that a person's right to drive a car is properly based on the condition that he drive safely.

Featured here are some of the steps in obtaining a Kentucky driver's license. The eye test and written examination (below, left) are first on the agenda. If the prospective driver passes these tests, his next step is the circuit court clerk's office (below, right) where instruction permits are issued permitting beginning drivers to operate an automobile when a licensed driver is along.

Final and most crucial test comes when the applicant demonstrates his driving skill under the watchful eye of a State trooper (left and above).
