Due to this increased need for better educated men, many youth in the Production Council Associations have started leadership in providing educational credit for the dependents of the members of their own families. They feel that only students who have the ability and the desire to learn should be given credit for college work.

Roughly, the loans work like this: twenty-five percent of balance to be repaid during the year advanced, the entire maturity seventy-five percent of the total money advanced. The money advanced each year is set up and commensurate with the graduate's ability to repay. For example, take a four-year college loan of \$6,000.00, annually. Of this amount \$750.00 advanced would be repaid after graduation. A renewal loan is set up and commensurate with the graduate's ability to repay.
